## FIRST REPORT (Presented on 25.5.1990)

- I, the Chairman of the Committee on Absence of

  by the Committee, present this their First Report.
- 2. The Committee held a sitting on the 24th May, 1990.
- The Committee considered applications for leave of absence from four Members. The recommendations of the Committee with respect to these applications are given in the Appendix.
- The Committee also considered the Question whether the letter dated 9th April, 1990 from Shri Atinder Pal Singh, M.P. (who is under detention in Tihar Central Jail, New Delhi and had completed 67 days of continuous absence from the sittings of the House on 24th May, 1990) to the Speaker requesting that he might be treated as present in the House till arrangements were made to bring him to the House daily by the Government, could be treated as an application for leave of absence from the sittings of the House. The Committee were of the opinion that the letter in Question could not be treated as an application in terms of Rule 242 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in Lok Sabha and that

Shri Atinder Pal Singh, M.P. be asked to apply for leave of absence in terms of Rule 242.
