3. During the year 1981-82 HMT exported 1,50,175 watches to the following countries:—

Bangladesh, Bhutan, Bahrain, Dubai, Ghana, Hong Kong, Iran, Iraq, Kenya, Kuwait, Luxembourg, Nepal, Nigeria, Norway, Oman, Qatar, Saudi Arabia, Singapore, Switzerland, Tanzania, USA, USSR, Zambia etc.

4. HMT watches so far exported are Gents and Ladies Handwound watches. Based on the orders received, the follow-

ing models appear to be relatively more popular:—

Sona, Janta, Kohinoor, Vijay, Chetan, Chanakya, Tareeq, Priya, Asha, Smitha, Tara, Nutan

5. Import content of mechanical watches being manufactured in HMT factories at present is limited to about 2 per cent in the case of hand-wound watches and 5 per cent for Automatic Day-Date watches. Some watch component sets are also imported to meet a portion of the requirement of HMT-assisted watch assembly units.
