#### Increase in Science Seats

## \*374. SHRI S. M. KRISHNA: SHRI B. V. DESAI:

Will the Minister of EDUCATION AND CULTURE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that it has become imperative to increase the intake for science courses since more and more students are opting for science subjects;
- (b) if so, whether Delhi University and some other Universities have approached the University Grants Commission for increasing science seats;
- (c) whether it is also a fact that University Grants Commission has not been able to give its decision in the matter; and
- (d) if so, the reasons for delay in reaching some decision?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRIES OF EDUCATION AND CULTURE AND SOCIAL WELFARE (SHRIMATI SHEILA KAUL): (a) The actual enrolment in science courses during the last 5 years has been increasing marginally at an average rate of 0.3 per cent. This growth does not indicate the need for any significant increase in the in-take capacity in Science courses.

(b) Only the Delhi University had sought the approval of the University Grants Commission to increase the in-take capacity of Science Courses in its colleges during 1982-83.

(c) and (d) The Commission after examining the proposal has informed the University to consider increasing the seats by 10 per cent in science courses in existing colleges instead of opening these courses in more colleges.

### Reappearance of Malaria in Orissa

\*375. SHRI ARJUN SETHI: Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Central Government have taken steps on the re-appearance of malaria in various places in Orissa particularly in Cyclone affected areas;
- (b) if so, whether Government have sent any medical team to study the causes of fever, malaria and jaundi e cases brought to the notice of Government; and
  - (c) if so, the details in this regard?

THE MINISTER OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI B. SHAN-KARANAND): (a) to (c) There has been some decline in incidence of Mala a in Orissa during recent years. In cy one affected areas, however, a slight increase has been reported. A representative of D.G.H.S. visited the cyclone affe ted area in June, 1982 and on the basis of his recommendation, Bleaching powder and other medicines have been supplied to the State.

## Late running of Qutab-Narmada Express

\*376. SHRI BABURAO PARAN PE: Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether 150 Qutab-Narmada Fxpress is running constantly late; and
- (b) Only the Delhi University had sought ernment to run this train in time?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS AND IN THE DEPARTMENT OF PARLIAMEN-

TARY AFFAIRS (SHRI MALLIK-ARJUN): (a) The punctuality performance of 150 Up Nizamuddin-Jabalpur Kutab-Narmada Express has not been satisfactory during the last three months.

Written Answers

(b) The main causes affecting its punctual running are alarm chain pulling and tight margin available at Jabalpur where the rakes are maintained. With effect from 22nd July, 1982, an overlapping rake has been inducted into the service to improve its maintenance and to prevent late start ex. Jabalpur.

#### Deaths of Children due to Diarrhoca

\*377. SHRI ANANTHA RAMULU MALLU: Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government have conducted any survey regarding the death of minor children every year to diarrhoea Statewise;
  - (b) if so, the details in this regard; and
- (c) the remedial measures which have been dopted by Government in this regard?

THE MINISTER OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI B SHAN-KARANAND): (a) and (b) As there has not been any survey, authentic information in this regard is not available with the Government.

- (c) During the Sixth Five Year Plan 'he Government of India have initi ted a Diarrhoeal Diseases Control Programme. The salient features of the programme are:
  - (i) To impart short term training courses on oral Rehydration The rapy for medical, p ra-medical and other concerned officers a. Primary Health Centre level.
  - (ii) Dist.ibution of health education material to the level of Aux.lia y

Nurse Midwives at Primary Health Centres which will help in the treatment of diarrhoeal diseases in the rural areas.

(iii) Oral Rehydration Salt packet, are being distributed to health workers to treat diarrhoea cases to prevent dehydration which causes death in such cases.

Late running of trains between Maninad-Secunderabad and Adilabad-Mudkhed

\*378. SHRI UTTAM RATHOD: Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that the trains between Manmad-Secunderabad and Adilabad-Mudkhed in South Central Railway do not run in time;
- (b) whether it is a fact that they are many times delayed by a couple of hours; and
- (c) if so, whether Government propose to have a control office at Purna to control the movements of trains on Purna-Khandwa. Parli-Parbhani, Mudkhed-Adilabad and Nizemabad-Manmad sections?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS AND IN THE DEPARTMENT OF PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS (SHRI MALLIK-ARJUN): (a) and (b) The punctuality performance of trains on Adilabad-Mudkhed section has been satisfactory. The punctuality of the trains on Manmad-Secunderabad Section was not satisfactory and ranged from 50 to 68 per cent.

(c) A ontrol office at Purna is already controlling train movements on Purna-Manmad and Parbhani-Parli Vaijnath sections and the control office at Akola is controlling the train movements be ween Khandwa and Purna.
