THE MINISTER OF PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS, SPORTS AND WORKS AND HOUSING (SHRI BUTA SINGH): (a) and (b) The DDA has reported that the uptodate physical progress of work of 192 Self Financing Scheme flats is about 32%, which is behind the schedule

- (c) The DDA has reported that the main reasons for the slow progress of work are:--
 - (i) restricted supply of cement in the past;
 - (ii) acute shortage of coarse sand; and
 - (iii) special efforts to comply with the observation made by the Chief Engineer (Quality Control). Efforts are now being made to have the work completed at the earliest by speedy supply of material, intensified supervision etc.

Utilisation of Irrigation Potential

*118. SHRI M.V. CHANDRASHE-KHARA MURTHY: SHRI BHEEKHABHAI:

Will the Minister of IRRIGATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether State Governments have intimated the Union Government their agreement to take effective steps for increasing the utilisation of irrigation potential and extend the coverage under field channels to 1.8 million hectares;
- (b) if so, whether State Governments will need more funds for the purpose;
- (c) if so, to what extent Union Government will meet the requirement of funds for the purpose; and
- (d) how many States have already started implementing them?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF IRRIGATION (SHRI RAM NIWAS MIRDHA): (a) to (d) Under the Command Area Development Programme,

relatable to the approved Plan outlays for 1983-84, the State Governments have adopted a target of covering 1,3 million hectares by field channels. State Governments were informed that a Central grant of Rs. 25 crores could be made available for construction beyond the target and they have expressed readiness to take up an additional coverage of 0.5 million hectares by field channels. For the Annual Plan target of 1.3 million hectares provisions have been made by the States. Additional expenditure to the extent of Rs. 25 crores will be met by the Centre on the basis of additional target actually fulfilled by the States. The States have been made aware of this proposal of Central Assistance for 1983-84 for construction of field channels beyond their original targets. Whether they have started implementing this can be assessed after 8-10 months of the year have elapsed.

Extraction of Edible Oil
