Assassination and Kidnapping Attempts on N. A. M. Delegates at Palam Airport

*704. SHRI K. LAKKAPPA:
SHRI GULSHER AHMED:
Will the Minister of HOME Affairs be
pleased to state:

- (a) whether it has come to the notice of Government that some assassination/kidnapping attempts were made on the N.A.M. delegates at Palam Airport;
 - (b) if so, full facts thereof; and
 - (c) the action taken in the matter?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI P. VENKATASUB-

BAIAH): (a) The Government is not aware of any such incident.

(b) and (c) Do not arise.

SHRI K. LAKKAPPA: My question is based on a newspaper report, which appeared in THE HINDUSTAN TIMES of 6th March, 1983 under the caption 'Drama at Palam'. The newspaper report says:

"High tension drama was witnessed in the early hours of today when an Iranian military cargo aircraft made an unscheduled landing at Palam airport.

The airport authorities sounded a red alert as the aircraft crew refused to identify themselves despite requests from the control tower.

The aircraft is learnt to be American made C-130 with 14th military personnel on board. The plane brought a bullet-proof car, 3 motor cycles and some arms."

I would like to know whether there is any truth in this news item. Was there any attempt by the extremist elements to disrupt the successful Non-Alignment Conference, which took place in this country, under the able leadership of born leaders? I would like to know whether there is any truth in it and, if not....

MR. SPEAKER: If not, why not?

DR. SUBRAMANIAM SWAMY: Is he referring to Shri Morarji Desai?

MR. SPEAKER: If the Minister denies it, still he will not believe it.

SHRI K. LAKKAPPA: Was any investigation made on this reported news item? Has any effort been made to find out the truth?

SHRI P. VENKATASUBBAIAH: Before I answer the supplementary of Member, I would like to place on record the wonderful work done by the security staff in ensuring the arrangements and security functioning of the biggest conference over held in the country, in making a success of NAM and also Asiad.

Coming to the supplementary put by my hon. Friend, it is not factually correct. It is a fact that a plane did land at the Palam airport. It was intended to augment the security arrangments that were being made by us for the VIPs of those countries. When the Head of the State goes to another country, it is customary in certain countries for them to take along with them the security staff. The other things which are mentioned by Shri Lakkappa are not borne out by facts.

THE MINISTER OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI P.C. SETHI) : I would like to add that the matter was sorted out at the Palam itself by contacting the concerned Embassy and only 30 security people were allowed to get down and about 200 were asked to go back.

CHANDRA SHRI KRISHNA HALDER: What was the name of that country?

MR. SPEAKER: He has already said it.

SHRI ERA ANBARASU: Sir, is, it a fact...
