the gap between demand for and availability of indigenous edible oils may continue in the coming years. This gap has to be met through imports.

(c) A number of factors contribute to this situation. Some of these are inadequate production of oilseeds, increase in population, increase in per capita consumption of edible oils, etc.

Lack of Rainfall in Parts of Karnataka

*218. SHRI T. R. SHAMANNA : SHRI K. MALLANNA :

Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state :

(a) whether it has come to the notice of Government that though there are heavy rains in many parts of the country, there is no rainfall at all in many parts of Karnataka;

(b) whether the sowing period has come to an end and many lands are not still ploughed; and

(c) whether Government propose to send a study team early to examine the matter and give adequate relief?

THE MINISTER OF AGRICUL-TURE (RAO BIRENDRA SINGH): (a) According to the information made available by India Meteorological Department, rains have been excess or normal all over the State of Karnataka upto 25th July, 1984, except in two districts namely, Chikmonglur and Chitradurg.

(b) As per information furnished by the State Government, there was deficiency in rain up-till middle of 'July in some parts of the State. By that time the sowing season for early crops, like carly Jowar, Sesamum, Groundnut and Green gram was over. In view of rains in the second and third week of July, ploughing operations are in progress. Sowing of minor millets, pulses like Horsegram, Cowpeas etc. and Sunflower and to some extent Rogi would be continued up to the and of August.

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(c) The question of sending a Central Team on Relief will be taken up after receipt of any such request from the State Government in the from of a memorandum.

Sale of Spurious Fertilizers to Farmers

Will the Minister of AGRICUL. TURE be pleased to state ; (a) whether Government's attention has been drawn to news-item in Indian Express of 10 July, 1984 wherein it has been stated that there has been sale of Spurious Fertilizers to Punjab farmers;

(b) whether spurious fertilizers have also been sold in some other States :

(c) how far it has affected the crops; and

(d) what action Government have taken to avoid its recurrence?

THE MINISTER OF AGRI-CULTURE (RAO BIRENDRA SINGH) : (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) and (c) A few isolated complaints with regard to some other Stetes have also been received, some of which could not be substantiated.

Considering the massive quantity of fertilisers being distributed and the very small number of cases of sale/ distribution of spurious/sub-standard/ adulterated fertilisers reported, the effect on the crops, by and large, will be insignificant.

(d) A Central Team was sent to Punjab to enquire into the allegations contained in the News-item. From the report of the Central Team as also the comments of the Government of Punjab, it appears that the news paper report is not factually correct. The Government of Punjab have also assured that all necessary action is taken to check the quality of fertilisers and punish the quilty persons.

The Central Government have also time and again impreseed upon the State Governments to gear up and strengthen their enforcement machinery and to mount special campaigns for checking fertiliser quality. Central Teams are also sent from time to time for checking quality of fertilisers at field level. The Central Government is also strengthening the Quality Control arrangements at the National and Regional level.
