बाणिज्य मंत्रालय में और पूर्ति विभाग में राज्य मंत्री (श्री निहार रंजर लास्कर) : (क) कच्ची खालों तथा चमड़े पर निर्यात के लिये रोक है। अर्ध-संसाधित तथा परिष्कृत सालों व चमड़े तथा चमड़े के उत्पादों का निर्यात किया जाता है।

- (ख) और (ग) 1983-84 (अप्रैल, 1983 फरवरी, 1984) के दौरान चमड़े तथा चमड़े के उत्पादों के निर्यात लगभग 376 करोड़ ६० के थे। जिन मूख्य देशों को ये निर्यात किये गये उनमें सोवियत संघ, जर्मन लोकतंत्रीय गणराज्य, इटली, जर्मन संघीय गणराज्य, फ्रांस यू० के०, संयुक्त राज्य अमरीका और जापान शामिल हैं।
- (घ) इस क्षेत्र में 1984-85 के लिए निर्यात लक्ष्यों का मृत्यांकन किया जा रहा है।

Boosting of Exports Through Inland Container Depots

- SHRI G. Y. KRISHNAN: Will the Minister of COMMERCE be pleased to state :
- (a) whether there is any proposal under the consideration of Government to boost exports through the inland container depots (ICD); and
 - (b) if so, the details in this regard?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE AND IN THE DEPARTMENT OF SUPPLY (SHRI NIHAR RANJAN LASKAR): (a) and (b) To facilitate exporters in the Inland Centres, Inland Container Depots (ICDs) have been set up on pilot Project basis by the Indian Railways at Bangalore Cantonment, Guntur/ Anaparti, Coimbatore and Pragati Maidan (New Delhi). A decision has also been taken to set up an ICD at Gauhati. the facilities that normally exist at the maritime ports, like Warehousing, Customs clearance, stuffing/destuffing, banking, services of shipping lines/steamer agents are made available at these Inland Container Depots. Inland Cotainer Depots enable the shippers to secure the much needed facilities of direct booking of export shipments in container loads through intermodal transport These facilities will help to promote exports.

Proposal to Ban Bird Hunting at All Lakes in the Country

- *933. SHRI LAKSHMAN MALLICK: Will the Minister of TOURISM AND CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:
- (a) whether there is any proposal under consideration of Government to ban bird hunting at all the lakes of the country for their beautification; and
- (b) if so, the steps proposed to be taken to increase the tourists potentialities of the lakes having national importance?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF TOURISM AND CIVIL AVIATION (SHRI KHURSHEED ALAM KHAN): (a) and (b) There is a complete ban on hunting of birds in the States and Union Territories of Andhra Pradesh, Gujrat, Himachal Pradesh, Kerala, Karnataka, Orissa, Meghalaya, Goa, Sikkim, Tamil Nadu, Uttar Pradesh, West Bengal, Chandigarh and Dadra and Nagar Haveli.

In Assam, Haryana, Madhya Pradesh Maharashtra and Rajasthan restricted hunting limited to a few species during specified seasons is permitted.

Development of tourist facilities lakes which are primarily bird sanctuaries is taken up by the Central Department of Tourism as a part of its regular Wild Life Tourism Development Programme, keeping in view the tourist market demand, inter-sepriorities, ecological aspect and availabitity The Central Department of Tourism has also a scheme for providing boats and other recreational facilitilo at lakes of tourist importance, in cosultation with the State Governments concerned.
