FIFTEENTH REPORT

Shri Altekar (North Satara): I beg to present the Fifteenth Report of the Committee on Absence of Members from the sittings of the House.

LOCK-OUT IN CASHEW-NUT FACTORIES

The Minister of Labour (Shri Khandubhai Desai): A strike was called by the Cashew Staff Association on the 16th May, 1956. Following the strike, the factories (about 33 in all) declared a lock-out affecting 25,000 workers and 1,400 other members of staff. The strike was called by the staff Association in pursuance of the following demands:

- (i) Staff to be made monthly paid.
- (ii) Salary and pay scales to be enhanced.
