LOCK-OUT IN CASHEW-NUT FACTORIES

The Minister of Labour (Shri Khan-dubhai Desai): A strike was called by the Cashew Staff Association on the 16th May, 1956. Following the strike, the factories (about 33 in all) declared a lock-out affecting 25,000 workers and 1,400 other members of staff. The strike was called by the staff Association in pursuance of the following demands:

- (i) Staff to be made monthly paid.
- (ii) Salary and pay scales to be enhanced.
