SHRI PALA K.M. MATHEW (Iduldi): Sir, the Dalit Christians in India are totally neglected section of the society. They are the Adi-Andhras, Adi-Dravidas, Adi-Kannadigas, Adi-Keralites known by their sub-castes like Pulayas, Paraihs etc. They suffer from the same social, educational and economic disabilities arising from the traditional practice of untouchability exactly like the Sched-
