STATEMENT RE: CORRECTION OF ANSWER TO STARRED QUESTION NO. 129

The Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister of External Affairs Sadath Ali Khan): In the answer given by me on the 14th February. 1958, to the Starred Question No. 129 by Shri Radha Raman, I had stated that according to the report received from the State Government, 15,586 acres of Indian territory in District Amritsar had been affected as result of changes in the course of the river Ravi till the end of 1957. Since then we have received a further report from the Punjab State Government which shows that on verification they found that the figures given carlier by them were not correct. According to the verified figures the position is that during the period from August 15, 1947 to December 31, 1957 the total Indian area lost as a result of changes in the course of the river Ravi came to 10,276 acres. This acreage covers the entire area of 11 villages (3,611 acres) and portions of 33 other villages (6,665 acres).
