mation. I can only give the type of equipment that is generally required but not the details. I am prepared to give him the details any time he wants.

SHRI M. KATHAMUTHU: Do Government hope to achieve complete indigenisation?

SHRI K. HANUMANTHAIYA: Yes, Sir; that is our aim. In fact, I have asked the Railway Board to appoint a special team for the purpose of ultimately eliminating all these import contents. But there are some which, in the very nature of things, we cannot manufacture. There may be some marginal items which we may have to import, but I agree with the hon. Member; we are pursuing that policy.

Overbridge near Safdar jang Aerodrome New Delhi

- *9. SHRI AMAR NATH CHAWLA: Will the Minister of RAIWAYS be pleased to refer to the reply given to Unstarred Question No. 1376 on the 23rd November, 1971 and state:
- (a) whether it has been decided to construct an overbridge on the Railway crossing near Safdarjang Airport, New Delhi;
- (b) the target date fixed for its completion; and
- (c) whether the estimates sanctioned earlier for its construction have been revised and if so, the revised estimates?

THE MINISTER OF RAILWAYS (SHRI K. HANUMANTHAIYA: (a) Yes, Sir.

- (b) 30.6.1973 for the bridge proper *i.e.* excluding approaches, to be constructed by the Railway.
- (c) The estimate sanctioned earlier is under revision.

SHRI K. HANUMANTHAIYA: The estimate is now likely to be Rs, 17,2 lakhs; that is for better amenities on the bridge also, A little more is going to be added to it.

SHRI K. HANUMANTHAIYA: For approaches the hon. Member has to approach the New Delhi Municipal authorities. I am concerned only with construction of the bridge.

SHRI N. K. SANGHI: It had probably been decided that the Safdarjang Airport would be given up for flying purposes. Now since the bridge is being constructed, may I know whether the Flying Club is going to operate there and the Airport is going to be continued?

SHRI K. HANUMANTHAIYA: The hon. Member might know that the concernfed authorities have come to some compromise and the railway bridge and the lighting will be so arranged as not to affect the operations of the Aerodrame. Therefore, the Flying Club will be there.

Finalisation of Sundarbans Delta Project Scheme

- *10. SHRI MADHURYYA HALDAR: Will the Minister of IRRIGATION AND POWER be pleased to state:
- (a) whether the Sundarbans Delta Project Scheme has been finalised; and

(b) if so, the estimated cost thereof and when it will be taken up.

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF IRRIGATION POWER (SHRI B. N. KUREEL): (a) and (b). The Sundarbans Delta project is a complex project of large magnitude. So far only preliminary investigations have been carried out by the Government of West Bengal. They have been advised to carry out detailed investigations and prepare a detailed project report, which is awaited.

SHRI MADHURYYA HALDAR: The hon, Minister, while replying to my question, said that Rs. 18 crores had been sanctioned for preliminary works. What are those preliminary works if the project is not yet finalinalised?

THE MINISTER OF IRRIGATION AND POWER (DR. K. L. RAO): Previously, only preliminary investigations were done. We have sent back the preliminary report asking them to send us a detailed project report. The first report was about the feasibility of undertaking the project, but a detailed project report is required and that we are awaiting from the West Bengal Government.

SHRI MADHURYYA HALDAR: Drainage in the Sundarbans is a very serious problem. What measures are the Government contemplating in this regard?

DR. K. L. RAO: The aim of the project is freeing an area of 50,000 hectares from the floods and ravages of the river and also protection for 82 villages. This is Phase I. This is the western portion of the Sunderbans. Besides this, there are other portions of the Sunderbans which will be taken up in Phases H and III.

SHRI SAKTI KUMAR SARKAR: The Chief Engineer too opposed this scheme and has also written something contrary against it. Will the hon Minister please tell us if it is so?

DR. K. L. RAO: There was an in-

vestigation done by the West Bengal Government engineers. I have seen their report. The project is quite feasible. Nobody objected to that. All that we wanted was a detailed project report giving complete estimates. As soon as we receive it, we will definitely try to take up the project. After completion of the First Phase, we will take up Phases II and III depending upon the success of the first phase of the project.
