A Central indigenously produced. Fertiliser Pool consisting of imported fertilisers is operated by the Central Government. The retail prices of fertilisers distributed from the Pool are fixed by the Central Government. The Central Fertiliser Pool is meant to operate on a no-loss-no-profit and provides for a periodical review of the financial position of the Focl. One such review is being made

(b) and (c). There was a steep increase in the prices of fertilisers, amounting on an average to 80 per cent, made with effect from the 1st June, 1974, caused by an enormous increase in the cost of imported feitilisers. To protect the interests of the small far mers in regard to purchase of fertilisers, the Government have increased the limit of production credit which can be availed of by the cultivators. In the areas covered by the Marginal Farmers and Agricultural Labourers Project, there is also a provision for marginal farmers having holdings upto one hectare, getting subsidises for inputs upto 33-1/3 per cent, subject to

a maximum of Rs. 100/_ per season and Rs. 200/- spread over two seasons in one year or two years.
