SHRI JYOTIRMOY BOSU Do you approve of that idea, Sir?

SHRIMATI INDIRA GANDHI We have already answered it

SHRI DHARAM BIR SINHA. The rules of accredition is very clear in the sense

that accredition is personal and not transferable. But, of course, the type of news agencies and newspapers are always taken into consideration. In this case after the accredition had lapsed, when the fresh application came for accredition, the Committee decided not to recommend to Government two of its other nominees.

## Big gap between Demand and Supply of Telephones

  Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS

- (a) whether a study of the development made in the telecommunications field reveals that inadequate understanding of the Country's requirements and faulty planning have created a big gap between demand and supply of telephones,
- (b) if so, the main findings of the said study, and
- (c) the action, if any that has been or is being taken on these findings,

THF MINISTER OF COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI H N BAHUGUNA) · (a) and (b) A statement is placed on the table of the Lok Sabha

(c) The Planning Commission has been allotting larger financial resources for the successive 5 year Plans and actions have already been taken to augment the indigenous production capacity of telecommunication stores and equipment. Two high-

Power Committees have recently been appointed to frame perspective plans and suggestions to progressively bridge the gap between requirement and availability of material and equipment and to modernise the telecommunication technology.

## Statement

(a) and (b) The development of telecommunications has been constantly under

review and in the 25 years since Independence and the growth m telephone service has been more than 11 times. Efforts have continuously been made to reduce the gap between demand and supply by executing successive 5 year Plans, each about  $2\frac{1}{2}$  times the former, but some gap is inevitable due to shortage of resources both financial and material. The position year by year of progress made and the waiting list is shown below

SHRI JYOTIRMOY BOSU . I have to point this out again as I did yesterday with regard to the Foreign Trade Ministry The figure has been given about the waiting list as 1-4-1971 The figure as given by the Government is 3 10 It is the first time I see after the decimal that they mention the word zero I am not quite educated for The figure to my knowledge is 34 lakhs of applications on that date Bahuguna, you have tried to undermine the whole thing I want to ask this question What has happened to the second Switch Factory which is supposed to come up or to be established, to augument the output of the Indian Telephone Industries at Bangalore and the second Cable Factory under construction at Hyderabad? How soon will they be ready and when will they come for production?

SHRI H N BAHUGUNA So far as the second switching factory is concerned, it is proposed to have a 300,000—line switching capacity factory, but the project report is still awaited

As regards the second cable factory at Hyderabad, the Industrial Development Ministry deal with it but they have advised us that they have already cleared the project

SHRI JYOTIRMOY BOSU I only asked a very simple question When does he feel that it will come into production? We do not understand these high-power talks. We are simple village people

SHRI H N BAHUGUNA I only hope and pray that our villagers will not turn the way Shri Jyotirmoy Bosu has done However, my hon friend is entitled to know when it will come into production I may tell him that the project report in one case is expected to be received, and we are expecting to start it, it will take from the date of clearance of the project anywhere between three and three and a half years for it to come any production

So far as the cable factory is concerned, I have already said that the Industrial Development Ministry have informed us that they have cleared the project

SHRI JYOTIRMOY BOSU Apart from the long waiting list the people have to put up with a lot of difficulty, with all the tall claim that the hon Minister and his Government have been making. There are serious complaints to the effect that now a telepnone may not be sanctioned even if a person's turn comes, but he has to approach

the Department for getting a sanction and also for getting a telephone, and unless he knows somebody at the top, and unless he is a VIP or an MP

MR SPEAKFR Let him put the question now

SHRI JYOTIRMOY BOSU My question is this Why is it that when a man gets his turn for a telephone, he has yet to wait for a sanction or he has to do *chaploosi* to a big man in order to get a connection?

MR SPEAKER This is not a simple villager's question

SHRI JYOHRMOY BOSU Chaploosi is a layman's word

SHRI H N BAHUGUNA I refute the allegation that there is something like chaploosi in the matter of getting a telephoneconnection But it is true that the situation is as correctly projected by him, in the sense that we do not have enough telephones to Therefore, some priorities have been given for example in the case of those people who are very sick, for instance, supposing somebody is sick with cancer, there have been cases where hon Members have recommended that they be given out-of-turn connection Political parties recognised by the Election Commission, even though their membership may not be large, have been given telephones in every district

So far as the other things are concerned, I may say that there is no other consideration in this except priorities

SHRI JYOTIRMOY BOSU Do they have any intention to impose a ceiling on telephone ownership? At present, one man can have even five connections

SHRI PILOO MODY That is what the man of many virtues has said

SHRI INDRAJIT GUPTA May I know whether this shortage of telephones and telephone equipment is largely due to the defective cross-bar equipment which has been manufactured in the I.T I under contract with the Bell Telephone Manufactured ing Company which is itself a subsidiary of the International Telephone and Telegraph Corporation and which itself has been ex-

posed by Mr Jack Anderson in the U S A as being an agency of the C I A? I would like to know whether the agreement which has recently expired with the Bell Telephone Manufacturing Company is going to be renewed or not and what steps are going to be taken in respect of the defective equipment which they are known to have supplied or to be more precise have supplied through the I T I, because they were the designers and the collaborators for it?

MR SPEAKER It is within the scope of the mam question but I do not know whether the hon Minister has the information with him just now

SHRI PILOO MODY Switch to Soviet Radio

SHRI INDRAJIT GUPTA The crossbar equipment which they manufactured has proved to be defective

SHRI H N BAHUGUNA This question is entirely different from the main question, but I shall try to answer it a little bit. It is not that due to defective technology the production has been slack, production has been slack for many reasons other than this. However, all these defects in technology have been identified, and we have prevailed upon the B T. M to pay for these corrections which would lead to making the equipment to order

SHRI INDRAJIT GUPTA What about the agreement?

SHRI H N BAHUGUNA So far as the agreement is concerned, so long as the B T. M's job of rectification is on, the thinking in the Department is that we might ask them to continue the collaboration without expecting any fees from us, we shall have to underwrite that they will pay for all the correctional steps and supply the material required for putting the equipment in order

SHRI INDRAJIT GUPTA He will allow the C I. A agency to go on function mg here?

SHRI PILOO MODY Switch to Moscow Radio, peace and progress, God knows peace of what SHRI RAGHUNANDAN LAL BHATIA. In view of the fact that there is a large number of applicants waiting, a new scheme was introduced that people who paid Rs. 2500 would be supplied with telephones immediately, but we find that there are very large number of applicants who are still waiting. May I know whether the Department will supply telephones at least to those we have paid Rs 2500?

SHRI H N. BAHUGUNA Firstly, the Rs 2500 scheme did not apply in the blanket manner in which the hon Member says it did We only give a certain percent age to these people Otherwise the poorer section of people and institutions would suffer. Secondly, even if they paid the amount, we would not be in position to supply to all of them
