श्री विभूति मिश्र : दिल्ली में जो पंजाबी बसते हैं, वे सरकारी डेरी से दूध नहीं लेते हैं बल्कि वे प्राइवेट डेरीज से लेते हैं, क्योंकि वे धारोष्ण दूध लेना चाहते हैं। इन प्राइवेट डेरीज को सरकार हटा भी नहीं सकती है। इस स्थिति में क्या सरकार उन को लोन और सहायता दे कर मजबूत करेगी ?

प्रो० शेर सिंह : यह सवाल तो अनएम्प-राइज्ड डेरीज के बारे में है—उन डेरीज के बारे में, जो उन स्थानों पर बना ली गई है, जहां वे नहीं बननी चाहिए थीं। अगर अब हम उन को और सहायता भी देना शुरू कर दें, तो बाद में माननीय सदस्य उन को हटाने की बात कैसे करेंगे।

श्री विभूति मिश्र : पंजाबी धारोष्ण दूध चाहते हैं, लेकिन वह उनको नहीं मिलता है। मैं यह जानना चाहता हूँ कि सरकार धारोष्ण दूध के लिए क्या इन्तजाम सोच रही है।

प्रो० शेर सिंह : जो लोग धारोष्ण दूध लेना चाहते हैं, वे एषराइज्ड डेरीज से ले सकते हैं।

SHRI B. K. DASCHOWDHURY: The hon. Minister said some time back that the green revolution will be followed by the white revolution with the increase in the supply of milk. I would like to know from the hon. Minister whether this scheme is the beginning of the white revolution in the country. If so, may I know whether the government have got any other schemes to start, at least in a small, simple manner, chilling stations in almost all the districts in the country in a phased way? Thirdly, out
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of the sum of Rs. 5 crores to be distributed among the States, what is the break-up for the various States?

PROF. SHER SINGH: The "Operation Flood" is meant, to begin with, for supply of milk to four metropolitan cities and for production of more milk in milk-shed areas attached to four metropolitan cities. We will spend Rs. 95.4 crores. So far, we have given about Rs. 10.73 crores. The total funds generated are Rs. 10.06 crores. In addition to "Operation Flood" programme, in the Fifth Plan, we are thinking of creating other such complexes around the other big cities. We are trying to create five more such complexes around those cities whose population is more than 1 million. Through that also, we will cover a number of districts more. The Agricultural Commission has also made some recommendations. In all, we may be able to take 107 districts where this and other programmes will be started.

SHRI P. A. SAMINATHAN:

Will the Minister of EDUCATION, SOCIAL WELFARE AND CULTURE be pleased to state:

(a) whether attention of the Government has been drawn to the press reports in the Hindustan Times dated 23rd February, 1973 under the heading "Social welfare schemes to be axed";

(b) if so, the broad outlines of the proposal; and

(c) to what extent the social welfare programme will be cut in the Fifth Five Year Plan?

THE MINISTER OF EDUCATION, SOCIAL WELFARE AND CULTURE (PROF. S. NURUL HASAN): (a) Yes, Sir,

(b) and (c). The information which concerns a number of ministries is being collected and will be laid on the Table of the House in due course.

SHRI GIRIDHAR GOMANGO: May I know from the hon. Minister that the Ministry handling the social welfare programme, in particular, education, health and family planning, is understood to be disturbed by what is described in the report of the Finance Minister, to keep deficit financing and additional taxation proposals within reasonable limit and, if so, is it not true that poorer and weaker sections of the society will be affected in the general development programme?

PROF. S. NURUL HASAN: There is no doubt that so far as the Ministry of Education and Social Welfare is concerned, there has been some cut in the Plan allocation in the last year of the Fourth Plan. But as against this, we are hoping to get some additional allocations as advance action for the Fifth Plan. The question to which the hon. Member refers relates to a number of other Ministries all of which have been grouped under the general term "Social Welfare" which includes Health, Family Planning and I have no doubt that it would also include the question of weaker sections which is under the Home Ministry. Therefore, it is not possible for me to straightway give all the information which he needs. But I can assure him that so far as the Fifth Plan is concerned, I think, there will be a substantial increase in the allocation for various social services in the Fifth Plan and many of these services have been included in the minimum-needs programme for the Fifth Plan period.

SHRI GIRIDHAR GOMANGO: May I know whether the axe fall on those items which are not considered "unproductive" and, if so, what are the "productive" and "unproductive" items?

PROF. S. NURUL HASAN: Our submission is that whatever we do to bring about welfare to all the people

is productive. We do not consider it unproductive at all.

MR. SPEAKER: Not in family planning.
