## Boundary Commission to settle Punjab and Haryana Territorial claims

(c) One of the applications is by the Narsinghpur Co-operative Sugar Mills Limited for the establishment of a new co-operative sugar factory with a cane crushing capacity of 1250 tonnes per day at Narsinghpur in Madhya Pradesh.
