between India and the German Democratic Republic to undertake a joint research project to explore ionospheric wave absorption ; and

(b) if so, the terms and conditions of the agreement along with the expenditure (in terms of rupers and foreign exchange, separately) likely to be incurred on the project ?

THE MINISTER OF PLANNING AND MINISTER OF DEPATTMENT OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY (SHRI C. SUBRAMANIAM) : (a) The Government of India and the Government of the German Democratic Republic have signed a Protocol on 23rd June, 1971 enabling the G. D. R. to hand over an apparatus for measuring the ionompheric absorption of electro-Magnetic waves.

(b) A copy of the Protocal is laid on the Table of the House. [Placed in Liberary. See No. LT-708/71]

The apparatus is valued at about US \$ 200,000 equivalent to about Rs. 15 lakhs. The Indian side is responsible for the erection and upkeep of the apparatus for which no estimate of expenditure has been made.
