THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI ANNASAHEB P. SHINDE): (a) and (c). The State Governments have been advised to strengthen the public distribution system particulary in the rural and inaccessible areas and to open additional fair price shops wherever necessary.

(b) The latest position in each State has been called for and will be laid on the table of the Sabha on receipt.

Report of Agricultural Prices Commission for 1971-72 and views of Chief Ministers at their Conference held in October, 1971

- (a) whether Agricultural Price Commission in its report on the price policy for 1971-72 has called for better public distribution system;
- (b) if so, the other recommendations made in the Report;
- (c) whether they have recommended existing restrictions on inter-State movement of rice;
- (d) what is the price and procurement target set up by the Agricultural Prices Commission; and
- (e) whether the Chief Ministers at their recent Conference had endorsed the Agricultural price fixed by the Commission?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI

- ANNASAHEB P. SHINDE): (a) The Commission recommended strengthening of public distribution system.
  - (b) A statement is attached.
  - (c) Yes, Sir.
- (d) The Commission recommended continuance of last year's price of paddy and rice except for a marginal increase of Re. 1 per quintal in the prices of standard variety of paddy for the States of Jammu and Kashmir, Orissa and Tamil Nadu with corresponding change in the rice prices. The Commission recommended that Kharif coarse grains be purchased at the ruling market price within the range of Rs. 45/- to Rs. 55/- per quintal.

The commission recommended the procurement target for rice for 1971-72 season at 4'3 million tonnes and an indicative target for the Kharif coarse cereals at 0'5 million tonnes.

(e) The Chief Ministers generally agreed that the procurement prices of all Kharif cereals, viz, paddy, rice and coarse grains should continue at the last year's level. Marginal adjustments in the price of paddy/rice could be considered in the case of Jammu and Kashmir, Orissa and Tamil Nadu as recommended by the Commission.

- (b) Nothing be done at this stage to disturb the existing arrangements in regard to the inter-State movement of rice:
