In addition to above, following trains services had to be curtailed on day-to-day basis due to difficulty in finding passage on account of agitators holding-up trains for going towards Ayodhaya.

- (a) On 24.10.90, 10 pairs of Mail/Express trains and 2 pairs of passenger trains passing via Agra had to be short terminated due to passage difficulty in Agra Area.
- (b) On 27.10.90,23 pairs of Mail/Express trains passing via Jhansi and Bhatni had to be cancelled due to passage difficulty.
- (c) On 28.10.90.15 pairs of Express trains scheduled to pass via Bhatni and via Saharanpur had to be cancelled due to passage difficulty upto 1.11.90.
- (d) On 29.10.90, 14 pairs of Express trains scheduled to pass on Jhansi-Agra Section had to be short terminated due to passage difficulty. And another 4 pairs of Express trains had to be diverted via Bhopal-Nagda and Surat-Jalgaon Sections. These arrangements continued upto 1.11.90.

Raw material Depots for Import of Petrochemical Intermediaries

763. SHRILOKANATH CHOUDHURY: Will the Minister of PETROLEUM AND CHEMICALS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the State Governments were requested to collect relevant data regarding the proposal for setting up of Raw material depots for import of petrochemical intermediaries from the Middle East and other countries for the purpose of establishment of petrochemical industry and make available the same to the working group constituted for the purpose;
- (b) if so, whether the Orissa Government has already submitted the report; and

(c) if so, the details thereof and action taken thereon?

THE MINISTER OF PETROLEUM AND CHEMICALS AND MINISTER OF PARLIA-MENTARY AFFAIRS(SHRI SATYA PRAKASH MALVIYA): (a) to (c). The proposal made by the Government of Orissa for setting up of a Petro-chemical terminal at Paradeep has been considered by a Committee which has suggested that such a terminal facility at Pradeep Port is feasible. The Committee has also recommended that the organisation desiring to set up such a port facility may have to ascertain the demands from the down-stream units and also undertake detailed technoeconomic feasibility before an investment decision is attempted. The recommendations of the Committee have been made available to the State Government of Orissa for appropriate action. The State Government has also been requisite to contact the Ministry of Transport who are concerned with the development of ports.

Motor Spirit (MS) releases to retail outlets throughout the country are presently being made by providing a 4%
