THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOL-OGY (PROF. M.G.K. MENON): (a) to (c). Photographs of submerged Dwarka were taken from 1983 to December, 1989 by divers engaged or employed and trained by the Marine Archaeology Unit of National Institute of Oceanography (NIO), Goa, which is coducting underwater exploration of Dwarka. Divers of Indian Navy had not been engaged for this work. Some of the important photographs have been shown in the focus programme of Doordarshan. Further steps will be taken to show the story of Dwarka or appropriate media through these photographs and other analysis.

(d) and (e). The Marine Archaeology Unit of National Institute of Oceanography (NIO) is advised by a retired experienced archaeologist of Archaeological Survey of India. Evidence in the form of buildings of ancient Dwarka, besides antiquities such as the seals, pottery, inscriptions and metal and shell objects found there corroborate the historical authenticity of the submergence of an ancient coastal city referred to in various texts as Dwarka. Scientific data generated from these discoveries has also been useful for studying the sea level fluctuation, coastal erosion and palaeoclimate.
