(c) The above measures have resulted in consumers getting vegetables at reasonable prices.

Support Price of Paddy in Orissa

1293. SHRI A. N. SINGH DEO: Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state whether Union Government propose to increase minimum support price of paddy of different varieties in Orissa in view of rise in the minimum wages of agricultural labour?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE AND COOPERATION IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI NITISH KUMAR): On the basis of the recommendations of the Commission for Agricultural Costs and Prices (CACP), the Government of India fixed procurement/minimum support prices for agricultural commodities for the country as a whole. Prices are not fixed on regional basis. While making its recommendations, the

CACP inter-alia takes into account the changes in input costs including wages.
