(b) The Judge strength has been increased from time to time. Procedural improvements and modifications to speed up disposal of cases have been made. The various courts are taking suitable steps such as grouping of cases involving common questions of law, giving priority to cases requiring quick disposal, constitution of specialised benches, etc. The various recommendations contained in the report of the Arrears' Committee (Malimath Committee) which went into the problem of arrears in the High Courts, have been forwarded to all concerned such as State Governments, Central Ministries and all the High Courts.

The Benches are being so constituted in the Supreme Court that they function for a larger period and work so allocated that similar matters are posted before the same Bench.
