- (b) Conversion/Expansion programme for 90-91 for Nagpur Telephone system are as indicated below:
 - Expansion of Nagpur E-10B (i) main exchange from 10000 lines to 17500 lines. Work is in progress.
 - (ii) Installation of 3000 lines electronic exchange (RLU) at Sakardhasa.
 - Installation of 4000 lines E-10B (iii) main at VRCE.
 - Installation of 1500 lines Elec-(iv) tronic exchange (RLU) at NARI, work is in progress.
 - Replacement of 9900 lines (v)

exchange at Etwari has been planned.

- Replacement of exchange at (vi) Hingna and Kamplee by electronic exchange. (RLUs).
- (vii) Replacement of 3000 lines ICU X-bar TAX by 2000 lines digital TAX.
- (viii) Expansion of digital TAX from 2000 lines to 3000 lines.
