(b) if so the number of cities likely to be covered during the period upto March 1978 and

(c) the number of dwelling units likely to be constructed during the period?

(b) and (c) From its inception to 31 10-1977 HUDCO has sunctioned 654 schemes in 189 etites spread over 16 States and 4 Union Territories As regards idditional etites likely to be covered during the period upto March 1978 it is for the State Government agencies to come up with schemes to be financed by HUDCO and as such it is not possible to identify in advance the idditional chemis to be fin meed by HUDCO in various etites

The total number of dwellings sanctioned upto 1976-77 15 1 82,360 out of which 45810 were completed till 31-3-77 During 1977 78 the number of dwellings which are likely to be financed by HUDCO is around 79 000 This is on the basis of an average cost of Rs 10867 per house as sanctioned by HUDCO during 1976-77 and the plunned level of loan to be sanctioned during 1977-76 The actual number that would be completed during 1977-78 out of the dwellings sanctioned/likely с эе sanr tioned will depend on the pace of implementation of schemes by the borrowing agencies

(a) the concrete steps taken by Government to provide a meaningful lead for slum clearance and urban development schemes

(b) whether the breakthrough in slum clearance can be achieved only by providing sites and sources and

(c) if so the resume of the efforts taken so far in this deriction and firm guidelines if any issued for quicker and broadbased implementation?

THE MINISTER OF WORKS & HOUSING AND SUPPLY & REHA-BILITATION (SHRI SIKANDAR BAKHT) (a) A statement is placed on the Table of the Sabha

(b) and (c) The scheme of sites and service, which envisages provision of developed sites for self-help and or incremental housing is one of the solutions for housing for the lum Cwellers and economically weaker sections of the society The Central Government has not formulated any scheme for financing projects of sites and services.

The Housing and Urban Development Corporation has, however, sanctioned 14 projects of sites and services having an estimated cost of Rs 5 089 crores in the States of Gujarat Madhya Pradesh Maharashtra, Puajab and Uttar Pradesh The HUDCO has already taken up with other States the question of financing such a scheme Under the World Bank asusted projects similar programmes have been taken up in Madras and Calcutta

Statement

Urban Development and Slum Clearance are State subjects The Central Government, with a view to accelerate the development in these fields initiated the undermentioned schemes.

(a) Slum Clearance

The Central sector Slum Clearance/Improvement Scheme was staited in May, 1956 and this continued in the Central Sector upto 31st March, 1969 The basic feature of the scieme as to rehouse he slum uwallers at the existing sites or nearby and to provide minimum standards of enviroumental hygiene A financial assistance of Rs 34 318 crores was released to the State Governments during this period

This scheme was subsequently fransferred to the State Sector to be financed from the block losin and block grant pattern under the State Plan schemes

The Housing and Uiban Development Corporation which is a Central Government und striking has so far approved 28 housing schemes of the two slum clearance Boards of Gujarat and Tamil Nadu and have sunctioncd a loan of Rs 419161 lakhs This will result in construction of 6285 dwelling units

(b) Slum improvement

To improve the living conditions in slum areas the Central sector scheme for Environmental Improvement was initiated in 1972-73 under which 100 per cent grant was provided to the State Governments for undertaking projects of environmental immovement in 20 selected cities in the country This Central sector scheme was in operation upto 1973-74 Thereafter it was transferred to the State sector to be financed from State Plan funds An amount of Rs 20 11 crores has been released to the State Government and Union Territory Administration during this period.

(c) Urban Development:

(i) During the Third Plan, the Scheme for preparation of Development Plans Master Plans for major metropolitan centres. State capitala port towns lapidly growing industrial areas and the resource regions was taken up as a Centrally sponsored sc-Under this scheme financial heme assistance was provided to the State Governments for preparation of 72 Master Plans According to infoimation available, the Master Plans' Development Plans have been preparcd for over 500 cities and towns by now

(11) During the 5th Plan two undermentioned Central schemes have been introduced

(1) Scheme for Integrated Urban Development in Mctiopolitan Cities and Areas of National Importance and

(11) Schume for Development of National Capital Region Central loan assistance under these schemes is being provided for development of cities and towns. So fai Rs 3838 crores covering 19 towns have been released under the inte rated Urban D velopment Programme, and Rs 255 crores for 4 to vns for the National Capital Region

(m) The Housing and Uiban Development Corporation has also financed 657 schemes for a total loan amount of Rs 280 90 crores The construction of houses shopping centres office, buildings and development of clots under these schemes wil naturally contribute to urban development Of these there are 19 projects which wil help in mitiating the development process either in new towns or in large extensions of piesent township in the form of housing, commercials or industrial development.
