(5) दिल्ली दुग्ध योजना के अन्तर्गत शेर के लिए कुछ मघन पशु विकास कार्यक्रम शीघ्र ही शुरू किए गए हैं। इन कार्यक्रमों के फलस्वरूप शोधित क्षेत्रों में दूध उत्पादन में वृद्धि होने की सम्भावना है।

(6) क्षेत्र में गाय के दूध की उपलब्धि बढ़ाने के लिए प्रतिदिन एक लाख लिटर दूध की क्षमता वाला एक बंटासिंग स्टेशन श्रीकानेर में स्थापित करने के लिए कार्यवाही की जा रही है।

(7) दिल्ली प्रशासन द्वारा 17-5-67 से छाया, सब्जी, पनीर तथा दूध पदार्थों के आयात, निर्यात तथा बिजली पर प्रतिबन्ध लगा दिया गया है जिसमें योजना को दूध की मण्डल कार्यक्रम रखने में सहायता मिली है।

Rice from Burma and Spain

The Minister of State in the Ministry of Food, Agriculture, Community Development and Cooperation (Shri Annasaheb Shinde): (a) and (b). The quantity of rice to be imported from Burma during 1967 under the existing arrangements is 215 thousand metric tons, of which over 100 thousand metric tons has already arrived. The shipments are required to be completed by the end of 1967. The payment for the rice is to be made in Pounds Sterling

(c) and (d) Two contracts have recently been entered into with two private parties for the import of 30 000 metric tons of Spanish rice. Shipments of this are to be completed by about the middle of August this year. The payment for the rice is to be made in Pounds Sterling.
