(c) Available data shows that a fall in employment in Tea Plantations has been primarily responsible for the deterioration in the employment situation, employment in this sector hardens recorded a fall of 18,086 or 38% during 1965 and of 11411 or 24% during 1966 A one-man committee has already reported to the Government on the employment position in Plantations The Report of this Committee is proposed to be placed before the Industrial Committee on Planta t ons in August 1967 and further steps will be taken after taking their recommendations into consideration
