**Allegations levelled by West Bengal
 Dy. Chief Minister against Minister
 of Home Affairs**

*809. Shri Ram Gopal Shalwale:

(a) whether he has received from
 the West Bengal Government the
 facts regarding the reported allega-
 tions by the Deputy Chief Minister
 of West Bengal against him to the
 effect that the latter had instigated
 officials to revolt;

(b) if so, the text of the report;
 and

(c) Government's reaction thereon?

The Minister of Home Affairs (Shri
 Y. B. Chavan): (a) and (b). Yes,
 Sir.

The West Bengal Government have
 stated that Deputy Chief Minister's
 speech as reported in the Statesman
 of 8th June, 1967 was generally cor-
 rect.

(c) The charge made by the Deputy
 Chief Minister of West Bengal is
 wholly unfair and unwarranted and
 is strongly repudiated.

**Pak. Trespass into South Berubari
 Village**

*810. Shri S. K. Tapuriah:
 Shri S. S. Kothari:

Will the Minister of Home Affairs
 be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that a gang
 of Pakistanis trespassed into Barni-
 para village in South Berubari on
 the 9th June and kidnapped a vil-
 lager Shri Mahendra Das; and

(b) if so, the action taken by Gov-
 ernment in this regard?

The Minister of Home Affairs (Shri
 Y. B. Chavan): (a) Five Pakistani
 nationals trespassed into the Indian
 territory at village Baraipara, Dis-
 trict Jalpaiguri, and kidnapped Shri
 Mahendra Das, an Indian national,
 while he was grazing his cattle near
 the border, on 9th June, 1967, Shri
 Mahendra Das returned to his village
 on the same day.

(b) A protest has been lodged by
 the State Government, demanding
 that stringent measures be taken
 against offenders and asking the
 Government of East Pakistan to pre-
 vent recurrence of such incidents.
