- (b) if so, the details of such arms smuggled;
- (c) whether such arms smuggled is connected with underground activities of any political party; and
 - (d) if so, the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF DEFENCE AND STEEL AND HEAVY ENGINEERING (SHRI SWARAN SINGH): (a) to (d). The Government of India have no information on the subject at present.

The Government of West Bengal have however been requested to furnish the required information which will be laid on the Table of the House on receipt.

Industrial Products for Exports

*218. SHRI CHENGALRAYA NAIDU : SHRI N. R. LASKAR : SHRI R. BARUA : SHRI MAYAVAN :

Will the Minister of FOREIGN TRADE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that Government are considering a proposal to reserve a part of Industrial products for exports;
- (b) whether it is also a fact that Government are considering an agreement under which any losses on exports can be shared equitably by various industrial units;
- (c) whether it is further a fact that Government have also formulated some additional policy guidelines to achieve the target of 7 per cent annual growth rate in exports; and
- (d) how far these proposals have been examined and put into practice?

THE MINISTER OF FOREIGN TRADE (SHRI B. R. BHAGAT): (a) Suggestions have been received in various forums to reserve a part of industrial products for exports. No concrete proposal has at present emerged.

(b) No, Sir.

(c) and (d). Broad policy guide-lines for achieving a rate of growth of 7% per year in exports have already been indicated in the Fourth Five Year Plan Document. The policies for the export of individual products will naturally differ from one product to another and vary from time to time and cannot be indicated in advance. Government endeavours to keep the emerging problems of export under a constant watch and tries to evolve appropriate policies.

Rail Wagon Industry

- (a) the details of the orders for wagon exports from different countries secured this year;

(b) As against the licensed capacity of 38,459 four wheelers, the orders available for execution during the year 1969-70 are 26,554 numbers. Upto September, 1969, the combined out-turn from all wagon builders (in terms of four-wheelers) is 6,493,5.

(c) A regular programme of market surveys, publicity through publications and advertisements, participation in exhibitions and fairs, sponsoring of delegations and study teams, etc. is undertaken through the agency of Engineering Export Promotion Council for promotion of engineering goods as a whole including railway wagons/coaches.

The Rolling Stock Export Association of which all the major wagon manufacturers are members is specifically concerned with the export of rolling stock. The State Trading Corporation, which is a foundermember of this Association, spearheads the export drive and co-ordinates the export of railway wagons.
