**MODERNIZATION OF POLICE FORCES**

**1602. SHRI MANOJ KOTAK:**

**Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether modernization of police forces has remained on top priority in the Government's agenda;**
- (b) if so, the details thereof;**
- (c) whether State Action Plans (SAPs) for modernisation of police forces has been approved; and**
- (d) if so, the details thereof along with the funds allocated for implementation of SAP?**

**ANSWER**

**(a) : The Government of India has, on 27.09.2017, approved implementation of the umbrella scheme of "Modernisation of Police Forces(MPF)". The umbrella scheme has two verticals – Security Related Expenditure (SRE) of specific theatres & Modernisation of Police Forces. Salient features of the Modernisation of Police Forces vertical are given below:**

- Central assistance is provided to the State Governments for weapons, equipment for Forensics, Information Technology, Communication,**

**Training, etc. The scheme is focused on facilitating targeted interventions and 'mobility' and 'construction of police infrastructure including housing' is now permitted in case of Jammu & Kashmir, insurgency affected North Eastern (NE) States and Left Wing Extremism (LWE) affected Districts.**

- **Three Himalayan States, namely, Jammu & Kashmir, Uttarakhand and Himachal Pradesh and 8 North Eastern States including Sikkim are eligible to receive financial assistance on 90:10 Centre:State sharing basis. The remaining States are eligible for financial assistance on 60:40 Centre: State sharing basis.**
- **Assistance for specific projects in the North-East region.**
- **Approved central outlay is Rs. 7,380 crore for the 3 years' period from 2017-18 to 2019-20.**

**(c) & (d) : State Action Plans (SAPs) of 25 States for the financial year 2019-20 under the sub-scheme of Assistance to States for Modernisation of Police have been approved by High Powered Committee (HPC). State-wise details of funds allocated under the sub-scheme of 'Assistance to States for Modernisation of Police' during current year, i.e., 2019-20 is at Annexure.**
