Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to establish Kendriya Vidyalayas (KVs) for the development of qualitative education in the educationally backward districts of the country and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether there is no Kendriya Vidyalaya in Supaul district of Bihar due to which the students are not getting the benefits of this scheme of the Government and if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the time by which the Government proposes to establish Kendriya Vidyalaya in Supaul district of Bihar so that the students of this educationally backward district may get better qualitative educational environment?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI RAMESH POKHRIYAL 'NISHANK')

- (a) No such proposal is under consideration at present. Proposals for opening of new Kendriya Vidyalayas (KVs) are considered only if sponsored by Ministries or Departments of the Government of India / State Governments / Union Territories Administrations thereby committing resources for setting up a new KV as well as the availability of necessary sanction of the Government. The proposals received from various sponsoring authorities for opening of new KVs also have to compete among other proposals under the "Challenge Method".
- (b) & (c) 50 new KVs were sanctioned in the country in March, 2019 including one KV at 45th BN SSB, Beerpur, Distt. Supaul, Bihar.
