SHORTAGE OF CADAVERS

92. DR. UMESH G. JADHAV:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether there is a shortage of human cadavers in the medical institutions for teaching purpose;
- (b) if so, the details thereof in public and private institutions; and
- (c) the steps taken by the Government in this regard?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI ASHWINI KUMAR CHOUBEY)

(a) to (c): MCI regulations prescribe for having mandatory cadavers in medical colleges / institutions for teaching purpose. However, no data regarding shortage of human cadavers for medical education in the country is maintained centrally.
