REVIVAL OF MICRO ENTERPRISES

1636. SHRIMATI QUEEN OJA:

Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Micro Enterprises which are traditionally manufacturing various useful important items of brass and bell metal but due to want of funds and infrastructure, the enterprises are going to disappear from Assamese Society and as a result of which upcoming generation would not be getting such brass and bell metallic items in the society, if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether any steps have been taken by the Union Government to revive these Micro Enterprises for the larger interest of public in Assam in particular and North Eastern Region in general;
- (c) if so, the details thereof and the steps taken in this regard; and
- (d) the time by which it is likely to be done.
