(a) and (b) Yes Sir. The Recycling of Ships Bill, 2019 has been passed by Lok Sabha on 03.12. 2019 and by Rajya Sabha on 09.12.2019.

(c)and (d) Yes Sir. India has acceded to the Hong Kong International Convention for Safe and Environmentally Sound Recycling of Ships, 2009 on 28.11.2019.

(e) Government has issued the Shipbreaking Code (Revised), 2013 to regulate the ship breaking and recycling in the country.
