- (a) and (b) Government have approved proposal to set up solar park of 2000 MW capacity at Pavagada in Karnataka under Development of Solar Parks and Ultra Mega Solar Power Projects scheme of the Ministry of New and Renewable Energy.
- (c) and (d) As on 31.12.2019, Central Financial Assistance of about Rs. 305.025 Crore has been released for the solar park at Pavagada in Karnataka.
- (e) Solar projects of 2000 MW capacity have been reported as commissioned in Pavagada Solar Park with five 500 MVA transformers for external transmission system
