**ASSISTANCE UNDER KRISHI KALYAN ABHIYAN**

3788. SHRI JOHN BARLA:

Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE कृषि एवं किसान कल्याण मंत्री be pleased to state:

- (a) the types of assistance provided to farmers under programmes like Krishi Kalyan Abhiyan which are run by the Government from time to time to help the farmers;
- (b) the number of times it is organised;
- (c) the basic facilities provided to the farmers under this scheme; and
- (d) the number of villages benefited or the number of villages in which it was organised during the last two years and the current year?

**ANSWER**

(a) to (d): Krishi Kalyan Abhiyan (KKA) was launched with a focus to give a boost to agriculture and allied activities for augmenting the income of farmers in 117 Aspirational districts selected from all the States/ UTs in the country. So far to Krishi Kalyan Abhiyans have been organized from 1st June 2018 to 31<sup>st</sup> July 2018 (extended upto 15<sup>th</sup> August 2018) and 2<sup>nd</sup> October 2018 to 25<sup>th</sup> December 2018 (extended upto 25<sup>th</sup> January 2019) respectively. Under each Abhiyan, 25 villages each with more than 1000 population were covered in each Aspirational district. The details of activities carried out in Krishi Kalyan Abhiyan –I & II are as under:
