(a) & (b) The Government of India launched Smart Cities Mission (SCM) on 25 June 2015 for development of 100 cities as Smart Cities. The selection of 100 smart cities was conducted through a City Challenge Process in four rounds of selection from January, 2016 to June, 2018. New Town Kolkata in West Bengal has been selected in May 2016 to be developed as Smart City.
