- a) the number of tourist spots of Nabarangpur, Malkangiri and Koraput districts of ODISHA which have been identified by the Government during last five financial years;
- the funds allocated by the Government for the development of the said tourist spots;
- c) if so, the details thereof; and
- d) if not, the reasons therefor?

(a) to (c): No project has been sanctioned for Nabarangpur, Malkangiri and Koraput districts of Odisha in the last five financial years.

Ministry of Tourism has sanctioned following projects under the Swadesh Darshan, PRASHAD and Assistance to Central Agencies Schemes respectively in the State of Odisha:

- i. Development of Gopalpur, Barkul, Satapada and Tampara under the theme of Coastal Circuit for an amount of Rs. 70.82 Crore.
- ii. Infrastructure Development at Puri, Shree Jagannath Dham Ramachandi Prachi River front at Deuli under Mega Circuit for an amount of Rs. 50.00 Crore.
- iii. Joint Development of Puri Railway Station in association with Ministry of Railways for an amount of Rs. 6.15 Crore.
- (d): Projects under Swadesh Darshan and PRASHAD are sanctioned after proposal is received from State Government. It is subsequently evaluated as per the Scheme guidelines.
