STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (c) OF THE LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO.*375 FOR 29.03.2022 REGARDING RENAMING OF NEHRU YUVA KENDRA ASKED BY HON'BLE MP SHRI VISHNU DATT SHARMA:

- (a) At present, there is no such proposal under consideration.
- (b) Question does not arise.
- (c) Nehru Yuva Kendra Sangathan (NYKS), an autonomous organisation under the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, having its presence in 623 districts with wide network of village based Youth Clubs with an enrolment of about 50 Lakh rural Youth has the mandate to generate awareness; organization and mobilize rural Youth between the group of 15-29 years for developmental work in the villages, with emphasis on values, vision and volunteer action.

Youth from all sections of the society get opportunity to take part in the NYKS programs and activities. Over the years, the Youth have been given opportunity to participate in adventure camps, National Integration Camps, Lifeskill Education, Inter-state Youth Exchange Programs(Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat) and other Youth exchange Programs supported by Ministry of Home Affairs, namely the Tribal Youth Exchange Programs and the North-East Youth Exchange Programs. These programs enable to enhance the leadership qualities among the youth and also for the Youth to participate in Nation-building activities.
