# LOK SABHA UNSTARRED QUESTION NO. 5480 ANSWERED ON 05/04/2022

#### REVISION OF WAGES UNDER MGNREGS

#### 5480. SHRI BHARTRUHARI MAHTAB:

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the total amount of wages paid under Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGS) during the last five years ending March 2021, State/UT-wise:
- (b) whether the Government is aware of the fact that the remuneration paid under this scheme is much lower than the minimum wages fixed for agriculture labourers in many States;
- (c) if so, the details thereof along with a State-wise comparative Statement of the rate of MGNREGS wages and the minimum wages fixed for agricultural labourers;
- (d) whether the Government has taken note of the fact that there is a great demand for increase of the present wages of MGNREGS workers and if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) whether the Government proposes to revise the wages and if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

#### **ANSWER**

### MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SADHVI NIRANJAN JYOTI)

- (a): State/UT-wise details of fund releases on wage component under Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (Mahatma Gandhi NREGS) during the last five financial years 2016-17, 2017-18, 2018-19, 2019-20 and 2020-21 is given at **Annexure-I.**
- (b) to (e): Mahatma Gandhi NREGS is a demand driven wage employment programme which provide for the enhancement of livelihood security of the households in rural areas of the country by providing at least one hundred days of guaranteed wage employment in every financial year to every household whose adult members volunteer to do unskilled manual work. It provides livelihood security, i.e. fall back options for livelihood for the rural households, when no better employment opportunity is available.

As per Section 6 (1) of Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act (Mahatma Gandhi NREGA), 2005, the Central Government may by notification specify the wage rate for unskilled work for its beneficiaries. Accordingly, the Ministry of Rural Development notifies Mahatma Gandhi NREGA wage rate for every financial year for States/UTs. To compensate the Mahatma Gandhi NREGA workers against inflation, the Ministry of Rural Development revises the wage rate every year based on change in Consumer Price Index for Agricultural Labour (CPI-AL). If the calculated wage rate of any State is coming lower than the wage rate of previous financial year, it is being protected by maintaining the previous financial year wage rate. The revised wage rate is made applicable from 1<sup>st</sup> April of each financial year. However, State Governments can provide wage over and above the wage rate notified by the Central Government under Mahatma Gandhi NREGS.

State/UT-wise details of notified wage rates for unskilled workers under Mahatma Gandhi NREGS for the financial years 2021-22 and 2022-23 is given at **Annexure-II.**
