- (a) whether the Government has constituted any committee to assess the number of vacancies present across various Central Government Departments;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor:
- (c) whether the Government has any preliminary data on number of sanctioned and estimated vacancies present across various Central Government Departments and if so, the details of vacancies, department-wise;
- (d) the details of backlog posts which are yet to be filled during the last eleven years and the current year;
- (e) whether the Government is planning to release any job notifications other than UPSC and Staff Selection Commission between 2022-2023 and if so, the details thereof;
- (f) the details and status of ongoing job notifications of Central Government; and
- (g) whether the Government has any preliminary data of vacancies present in the States and if so, the details thereof, State-wise?

ANSWER

- (a) to (d): The details of Ministry-wise/Department-wise sanctioned strength and the number in position of employees, as on 01.03.2020, are at Annexure-I. Government monitors the progress in respect of filling of backlog reserved vacancies for SCs, STs and OBCs in ten Ministries/Departments, which contribute more than 90% of total number of employees of Central Government. Ministry/Department-wise, Category-wise details of backlog reserved vacancies for the years 2016 to 2020 are at Annexure-II.
- (e) to (g): Occurrence and filling of vacancies by various recruiting agencies of Central Government including Union Public Service Commission (UPSC) and Staff Selection Commission (SSC) is a continuous process on the basis of requisitioning by the respective Cadre Controlling Authorities (CCA). Data regarding vacancies filled by State recruiting agencies is maintained by the respective State Government.
